The Santa Iglesia Catedral, Seville's breathtaking **Cathedral**, was built on top of the largest Almohad mosque in ninth century Seville, erected by King Abd-al-Rahman II, on the same site as the earlier Byzantine Basílica de San Vicente.

The old mosque's minaret has been conserved, now as the Cathedral's nearly 100 meter-tall bell tower, crowned with a weathervane called the Giraldillo, from

which it takes its name, **Giralda**. The Patio de los Naranjos was also preserved – it used to be the courtyard where necessary ablutions were performed before entering the mosque.

Today it is the largest Gothic temple in the world and the third in all of Christianity, occupying 22.720 square meters.
